



MFC Semicirculus Monogram Guidebook

The inspiration source for Semicirculus Monogram is a stylish sans serif letterset from a vintage embroidery publication which combines to create a semi-circular form monogram. Originally intended to adorn handkerchiefs, it has so many other possibilities. Ornaments from numerous antique specimens books were combined with the letterset to accent and complete its form. This is one of many monogram designs from the early 1900's which fall into a two letter format that is either adorned or interwoven with ornamentation.

Semicirculus Monogram Style

Semicirculus Monogram is only capable of two letter monograms due to its unique design. Numerous ornaments are included to further accentuate and add sophistication to the monogram form.

To create a dynamic monogram, select MFC Semicirculus Monogram from your font menu, then just type a Capital, then a lowercase letter. If you have OpenType Ligatures enabled, the font will automatically type in the correct format for you.



Type E then n



Type G then b



Type H then z

If you want to create a more customized look, you could use a combination of the letter initials and the ornament accents for an added emphasis and unique flavor.



Simply type any numeral before your monogram to add an underside ornament and flair to your design.
